# THE SCREWTAPE LETTERS

Pastor Penny is currently leading a 4-week Sunday School class to during the month of June, on one of C.S. Lewis' classics - The Screwtape Letters. First published as a book in 1942, this year marks the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of this important book. Have you ever read it? Basically, Lewis re-imagines Hell as a gruesome bureaucracy where a senior demon - Screwtape - corresponds with his apprenticing nephew - Wormwood. The younger demon's assignment is to corrupt a newly converted young Christian man, living in London during the tumultuous days of World War II. In the letters Screwtape writes his nephew, Lewis examines Christian morality, temptation, good, and evil. It's a fascinating story and you can get a copy of the book for around \$15 at any local bookstore (or Pastor has a few paperback copies left for \$9 each).

The Sunday School class will meet on Sunday mornings during Sunday School time (9:40-10:20) in the Fellowship Hall, Sunday **June 4** - **Sunday June 25**<sup>th</sup>! It's never too late to join the

Specifically, we are in need of 5 or 6 volunteers to be *Crew Leaders*. The Crew Leaders are in charge of 5-10 of the VBS kids assigned to their "crew." The Crew Leader begins learning the names of the kids in his or her group, and begins building relationship with them, as the Leader guides the kids around to the five or six different stations (i.e. Crafts, Recreation, Snack, Bible Story, etc.). The Crew Leader doesn't have to "teach" any of the stations but does stay with their crew at each one. Actually, the job of Crew Leader would ideal for some of our Senior High Youth! Give it some thought and sign up today, if you are ready to make the commitment. Crew Leaders do have to attend each night and stay with their crew from 6-8:15p.m.

# C.S. LEWIS' MERE CHRISTIANITY

Lewis called Mere Christianity, "mere" meaning basic. His wonderful British humor and his sharp intellect shine brilliantly in this classic presentation of the basic tenets of the Christian faith. Come as often as you can, or just a couple of times, you will still enjoy a good discussion as we deepen faith and build fellowship.

### **VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES**

Since every member of our church family is a minister, we always have many opportunities for you to serve our LORD. Some of the ways are fun and visible and bring you recognition and joy. Other ways are kind of "behind-the-scenes" and while they serve the body of Christ, they don't bring a lot of recognition. All of these roles are important, for together, we are the body of Christ. Here are a few of the open roles we need filled at the moment:

- <u>Sunday School Superintendent</u> this person will do a weekly count of our Sunday School attendance, collect the Sunday School offerings and deliver to the office; work with Pastor Penny and the Sunday School teachers to plan and build up our Sunday School classes and brainstorm ideas to increase participation.
- Restore Décor Representative this person would be the contact person between NBUMC and the Restore Décor ministry in downtown Edwardsville. Restore Décor is looking for church folks to volunteer a couple of hours a week to help them prepare items for resale. Hours are flexible and the representative doesn't have to go every week, but would help find NBUMC folks to fill in the volunteer hour slots.
- <u>Recycling Person</u> NBUMC is committed to recycling as one of the many ways we seek to be good stewards of our resources and care for our planet. We need a volunteer to take our weekly collections of recycled paper home and place in their own recycle bin for pickup and recycling. New Bethel doesn't have a contract with the village so we don't have access to a recycling can.
- <u>Children's Worship Bags</u> We are looking for someone to come in once a week (i.e. Friday) and restock our Children's worship bags with coloring pages and puzzles for the next Sunday. We currently utilize 8 bags so the job wouldn't take more than 20-30 minutes a week.
