In the Old Testament, we meet a very interesting man who was forced to live in a fast changing and godless society. He faced normal fears about the future, urgent concerns for his safety, and the constant discouragement of a world that seemed to be falling apart at warp speed! Sound familiar? Join us in July as we study Daniel, for 31 days! Daniel was a faithful Jewish man who originally lived in Jerusalem, but was captured by the Babylonians and carted off to their homeland to be trained and educated so he could serve King Nebuchadnezzar. This happened around 605 B.C. Daniel and his friends suddenly found themselves in a foreign land, being coerced to eat, think, and live very differently from what they had been taught. The Babylonians were trying to change the thinking of these Jews by giving them a Babylonian education; their loyalty by changing their names to Babylonian names; and their life-style by changing their diet.

But Daniel was smart, creative, and very loyal to God. Without compromising his faith, Daniel and his friends found a way to live by God's standards in a culture that did not honor God. And they did this through negotiation, self-discipline, humility, and service. What pointers might we take from Daniel's faithfulness and integrity? Join us in July and find out!

SHIPWRECKED

Rescued by Jesus!
For kids ages Kindergarten - 5th grade!

Registration and helper sign-up is already underway! If you'd like to volunteer, speak with leaders **Dennis Wilson** (618-580-7178), **Pastor Penny** (217-932-3115) or **Linda Lawhead** (618-288-5700).

Specifically, we need of 5-6 volunteers to be *Crew Leaders*. The Crew Leaders are in charge of 5-10 of the VBS kids assigned to their "crew." The Crew Leader begins learning the names of the kids in his or her group, and begins building relationship with them, as the Leader guides the kids around to the five or six different stations (i.e. Crafts, Recreation, Snack, Bible Story, etc.). The Crew Leader doesn't have to "teach" any of the stations but does stay with their crew at each one. Actually, the job of Crew Leader would ideal for some of our Senior High Youth! Give it some thought and sign up today, if you are ready to make the commitment. Crew Leaders do have to attend each night and stay with their crew from 6-8:15p.m. J

Tropical Treats Leader - We are also in need of someone to be the leader for the snack station. We have a number of folks who have already volunteered to help, but we need to give the "snack book" to someone who wants to be in charge of planning each night's snacks. If you love kids and snacks and VBS chaos and fun, why not volunteer today?!

Ship Rec Games Leader - This person repeats the Bible Point each day and plays games with the kids that connect with the daily bible Point. Each day there are three fun game options to choose from, i.e. - on Day 3, kids explore through play how struggle isn't necessarily always a bad thing and how God can use it for good in their lives. Jesus can rescue through struggle!

Bible Discovery Leaders – these leaders help the children experience the daily bible story in a hands-on way. For example, on Day 2, kids will imagine their way back in time to Mary and Martha's house as both sisters anticipate Jesus' arrival.

KidVid Cinema Leader - The daily Bible verse is reinforced as children watch and discuss the inspiring true story featured in each day's video segment. The kids also practice using a Bible by finding and reading each day's key Bible verse and this leader gives each child the day's Bible Memory Buddy!

Castaway Sing and Play Leader - this leader opens each night of VBS in the Sanctuary by introducing the Bible Point, key Bible verses, and the Bible Memory Buddy. Kids sing the Shipwrecked theme song, "Never Let Go of Me," which connects with the daily Bible Points. In addition to fun praise songs, kids sing at least one song each day that specifically ties to that day's Bible point.

VBS DONATIONS - A VBS Donation list will be posted in the church lobby by the end of June. This helps us control our expenses and gives everyone the opportunity to support this important outreach and faith-building ministry. Watch for the list....
